Energy Advantages of Concrete

1. Made from local materials.
2. Any repairs can be made with local material.
3. No sealers needed over concrete.
4. No heating needed of concrete mix.
5. Less lighting energy required for light pavement.

Compared to Asphalt

1. Made from oil, often imported.
2. Repairs made with oil-based materials.
3. Oil-based sealers and face coats needed periodically.
4. Material must be heated when applied.
5. More lighting energy required for black pavement.
