- 2. Concrete needs little maintenance.
- 3 Plants in almost all communities.
- 4. Less lighting energy needed, fewer lighting standards.
- 5. Lowest cost for design life.
- 6. Car Maintenance can be reduced.

Compared to Asphalt

- 1. Cost fluctuates with oil cost.
- 2. Continuous maintenance, expensive repairs.
- 3. Plant sites sparse, long hauls.
- 4. Higher lighting costs, more lighting standards needed.
- 5. Possible lower first cost, but shorter life.
- 6. Ruts and potholes can cause car damage, liability.
