- 3 Lower crown, better vehicle control.
- 4. Runoff prevents hydroplaning.
- 5. Can be groved for better runoff.
- 6. Even-riding, smooth texture.
- 7. Long-lasting rumble strips can be installed.
- 8. Fewer lighting standards needed, fewer hazards.

Compared to Asphalt

- 1. Poor reflectance because of dark color means more light is needed.
- 2. Slippery when wet.
- 3. Greater crown, more difficult steering.
- 4. Rutting holds water.
- 5. Cannot be groved adequately.
- 6. Hazardous surface and potholes.
- 7. Asphalt rumble strips quickly worn down under traffic.
- 8. More lighting standards needed, more impact hazards.
