## **Project Description**

The Plaza in Clayton office building is a 16-story 341,000-square-foot facility with an accompanying 536,000-square-foot parking garage. Both are part of the Plaza's entire 1.2 million square-foot mixed-use development that also includes a residential tower and retail space. Clayco placed the first piece of construction equipment on the site of St. Louis' premier office project in late February 2002 and was on the fast track since inception, achieving completion in less than 20 months. Located at Carondelet Plaza and Hanley Road in Clayton, MO, adjacent to the Ritz-Carlton, the office tower features 26,000-square-foot floorplates. Ernst & Young LLP, Cap Gemini Ernst & Young and Northern Trust were among the first tenants to occupy space at The Plaza in Clayton.
